





- Clear definition objectives and necessary background to attend class:

 - students are oblige to assess teachers & course








- Continuous teachers learning :









- **Theory:** It's mandatory! But how to make it more challenging?

- Make it understandable and related to real life










Pedagogical Methods:

- Align the course syllabus & objectives with the assessment
- Be TRULY available for the students: interact with students










Pedagogical Methods:

- Give feedback on time: couple days after tests, reports and projects deliveries
- Be clear about what it's expected from the students
- Respect the diversity of students learning styles












Active learning methodologies

- Students must be involved in class, active learning means reflexive thinking about contents explained by teachers
- Students must relate contents to previous knowledge and experiences
- Must be a hands-on learning and not a "sit and listening" learning










Good teaching practices @ IST
